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## PROGRAM COMMITMENT

**Participate in six monthly sessions**

Each session runs 4 hours, on Saturdays.

**Complete a “commitment agreement”**

To outline your goals and a capstone project.

**Complete reading and/or “field practice”**

2 hours between sessions, 12 hours total.

**Co-facilitate at LISC’s leadership trainings**

Lead an activity at a Leading Together session.

**Connect to a coaching partner**

For 30-60 minutes between sessions.

**Fulfill a practicum**

Minimum of 10 hours of training, coaching or consulting upon completing the program.

**Remain “on-call”**

For additional training, consulting, and coaching on a volunteer and paid basis.
