Alief




Alief is located 12 miles southwest of Downtown Houston. The neighborhood is one of the most ethnically diverse areas in the city, with 46% of the residents born outside the United States in 2016. The Super Neighborhood's boundaries are Westpark Tollway on the north, Beltway 8 on the east, West Bellfort on the south, and near Synott Road on the west. Overall, the neighborhood covers approximately 14 square miles.

Our neighborhood is dense, with a population density twice as high as Houston


